Renew My Church... Renewed Concept of the Rectory and its Office

As some know, the rectory of Our Lady of the Rosary united parish is different from what many of us have known about rectories. Many of us grew up with the understanding that the rectory was both the residence of the parish priests as well as the central office where the business of the parish was conducted. For both priests and parishioners, the structure of most rectories left much to be desired. For priests, the traditional rectory often meant not only living above the store, but in the store. I recall that the first time that I came down with the flu after my ordination, I went downstairs in my bath robe and pajamas to the kitchen to make myself some chicken broth and toast. In the kitchen, I found assembled the director of religious education and some of her lead catechists engaged in a meeting. I was embarrassed. They were embarrassed. However, at that time, nothing changed.

As we consider how we would like our parish buildings to be used in our new reality, I hope that we will all be comfortable with clearer distinctions between the residence where the priests live and the place where parish business is conducted. At present, it looks as though our priests will live, at least for the next year at both Saint Bartholomew and Saint Pascal rectories. I believe that we will have six priests in residence at Our Lady of the Rosary. Of these, three will serve full time in the parish. Three priests will be assigned as residents with responsibility to assist with liturgical and pastoral demands. At the time of this writing, we are unsure as to which of the two residences the priests will be assigned to live. However, it would seem certain that priests will reside at both Saint Bartholomew and Saint Pascal.

Decisions are still being made about the best location for the parish offices. It seems that the former convent at Saint Bartholomew is proving to be an ideal location for parish offices and meeting spaces. Of course, the Neckermann room at Saint Pascal has much to commend itself for office and meeting space. We plan on maintaining spaces on both campuses, distinct from the living space for the priests, for meetings and parish business.

Renueva Mi Iglesia... Concepto renovado de la Rectoría y su Oficina

Como algunos saben, la rectoría de la parroquia unida de Nuestra Señora del Rosario es diferente de lo que muchos han sabido sobre las rectorías. Muchos de nosotros crecimos con el entendimiento de que la rectoría era tanto la residencia de los párrocos como la oficina central donde se llevaban a cabo los negocios de la parroquia. Tanto para los sacerdotes como para los feligreses, la estructura de la mayoría de las rectorías dejaba mucho que desear. Para los sacerdotes, la rectoría tradicional a menudo significaba no solo vivir encima de la tienda, sino también en la tienda. Recuerdo que la primera vez que contrae la gripe después de mi ordenación, bajé las escaleras con mi bata de baño y pijama a la cocina para hacerme un poco de caldo de pollo y tostadas. En la cocina, encontré reunidos a la directora de educación religiosa y algunos de sus catequistas principales participaron en una reunión. Estaba avergonzado. Estaban avergonzados. Sin embargo, en ese momento, nada cambió.

Al considerar cómo nos gustaría que nuestros edificios parroquiales se utilizaran en nuestra nueva realidad, espero que todos nos sintamos cómodos con distinciones más claras entre la residencia donde viven los sacerdotes y el lugar donde se llevan a cabo los negocios parroquiales. En la actualidad, parece que a través de nuestros sacerdotes vivirán, al menos durante el próximo año, en las rectorías de San Bartolomé y San Pascal. Creo que tendremos seis sacerdotes en residencia en Nuestra Señora del Rosario. De estos, tres servirán a tiempo completo en la parroquia. Tres sacerdotes serán asignados como residentes con la responsabilidad de ayudar con las demandas litúrgicas y pastorales. En el momento de escribir este artículo, no estamos seguros de cuál de las dos residencias se asignará a los sacerdotes para vivir. Sin embargo, parece seguro que los sacerdotes residirán tanto en San Bartolomé como en San Pascal.

Todavía se están tomando decisiones sobre la mejor ubicación para las oficinas parroquiales. Parece que el antiguo convento de San Bartolomé está demostrando ser un lugar ideal para las oficinas parroquiales y los espacios de reunión. Por supuesto, la sala Neckermann en St. Pascal tiene mucho que elogiarse por su oficina y espacio para reuniones. Planeamos mantener espacios en ambos campus, distintos del espacio vital para los sacerdotes, para reuniones y negocios parroquiales.

I have long hoped to create an office either within the church, possibly an underused sacristy or corner of the gathering space for a reception or office area. Such an area would offer easy access to the congregation to schedule Masses, obtain letters of permission, request sacramental records, complete certain canonical documents. At present, no decisions have been made about a reception/office area in any of our churches. I would welcome your thoughts,

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATIONS

BAPTISMS: Registration in the parish is a prerequisite. Parents must attend a Pre-Baptismal Preparation Session with the celebrant two months prior to the Baptism either in person or Zoom. For details regarding baptismal registration and requirements, please contact the parish office.

RECONCILIATION: Every Saturday at 9:00 AM at Saint Pascal and Saint Bartholomew.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY: Either the bride, the groom, or parent of either must be a registered and active parishioner for at least six months before contacting the parish to make arrangements. For Pre-Marriage Preparation and to secure the wedding date you prefer, please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance before confirming a reception hall. Arrangements can be made at the Parish Office by the bride and groom.

COMMUNION, CONFIRMATION AND CONVERSION:

Children: All children should be enrolled in the Religious Education Program from first through eighth grades if they are not in a Catholic School.

Adults: Please call the parish office to inquire about RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults).

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: Anytime a person is facing a serious illness, surgery or hospitalization, it is proper to receive the Sacrament of the Sick. Please contact the parish office. If the office is closed, please leave a message on a priest's voicemail.

MINISTRY OF CARE - HOMEBOUND PARISHIONERS:

Please notify the parish office there is someone you know who is unable to join us at Mass and would like to have the Eucharist brought to their home. Our Ministers of Care bring Holy Communion to those who are sick and homebound.

FUNERALS: When a family member dies, arrangements with the Church are usually made by the Funeral Home. Contact can also be made to the parish directly so priests and bereavement ministers may assist in planning the liturgy for the Funeral Mass, Wake Service and Final Commendation at the cemetery.

FIFTEEN YEARS OR SWEET SIXTEEN: Sixteen-fifteen year old young ladies who would like to celebrate their quinceañera should have been confirmed and received their First Holy Communion as well as a series of preparation for the celebration. Please call Mrs. Maria Arrez at the Office of Religious Education for details.

PRESENTATION OF A CHILD: When your child is 40 days or three years old, he/she may be presented in the church on the First Sunday of any month. Please call the parish office one week ahead to register your child.

GLUTEN FREE HOSTS: If you would like to receive a gluten free host, please notify the priest prior to the beginning of Mass so a gluten free host may be made available for you.

PREPARACIÓN SACRAMENTAL

BAUTISMOS: El registro en la parroquia es un requisito previo. Los padres deben asistir a una sesión de preparación pre-bautismal con el celebrante dos meses antes del bautismo, ya sea en persona o por Zoom.
